53	This vehicle (vessel) carries people and things on and across water bodies. What is it?	Ship
54	You place a lit candle inside this, and for a festival, you decorate many of them. What do you call this kind of light?	Lantern
55	What do you call a dead person's spirit that arises in the world of the living?	Ghost
56	I live in a forest or woods. I run around on the trees and eat fruit and nuts. I look like a rat but I have a long, fluffy tail. Who am I?	Squirrel
57	You mix Azuki beans (red sweet beans) with Kanten (Japanese gelatine) and steam it to make it hard. What do you call this candy?	"Yokan" (Sweet bean jelly that is a traditional Japanese sweet)
58	This surrounds a house and is made of wood or stone. What is it?	Fence
59	When you play on this piece of equipment in a park, you go up the ladder and slide down on the slope. What is it?	Slide

67	This vehicle uses electric power and carries people and things on a railroad track. What is it?	Train
68	This vehicle flies into space at high speed. What is it?	Rocket
